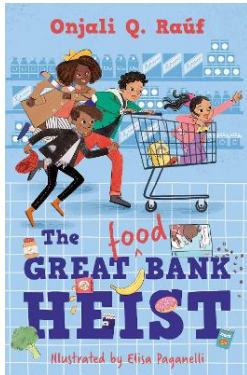


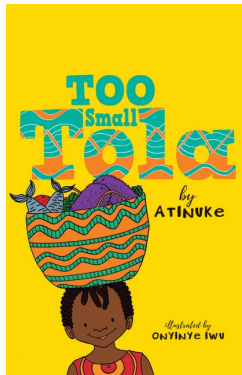

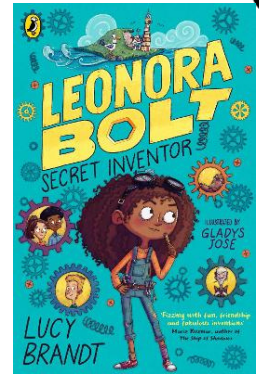
The Great Food Bank Heist

A story full of hope. A child's eye view of the increasing problem of food poverty. Dyslexia friendly.



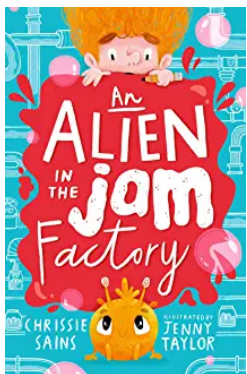
Too Small Tola

Three heart-warming stories about determined Tola, set in Lagos, Nigeria.



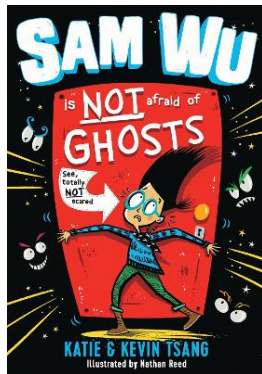
Leonora Bolt – Secret Inventor

A fantastic STEM-themed adventure about believing in brainpower and yourself.



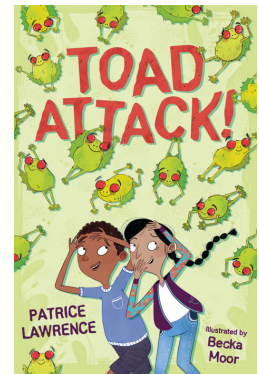
An Alien In The Jam Factory
