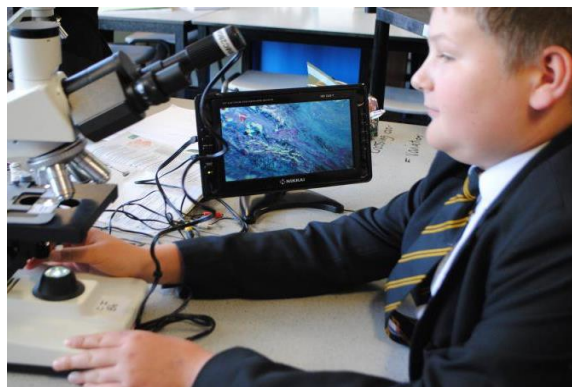

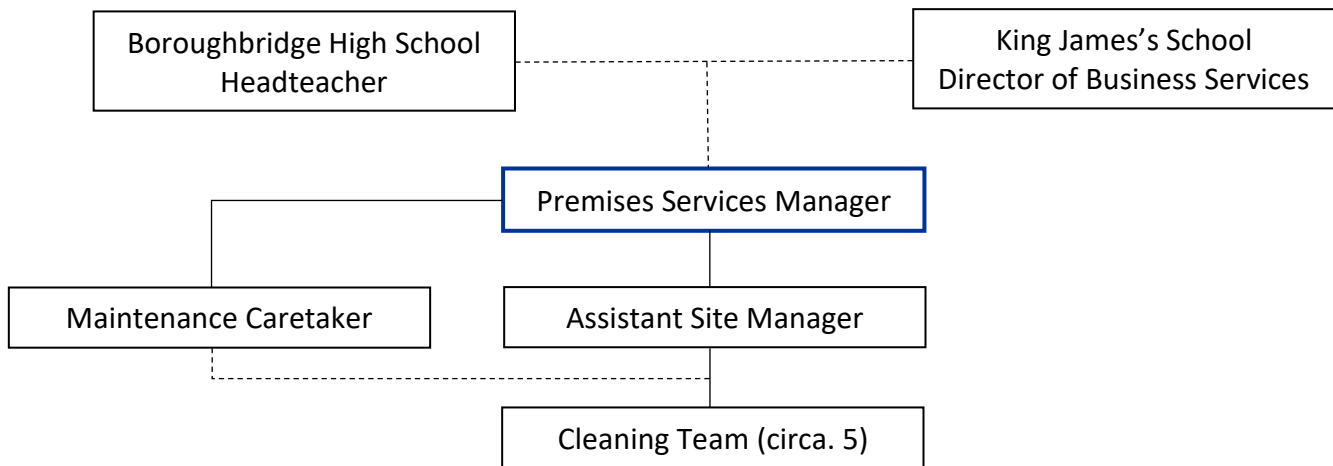
Information on the Site
