Children do well at school when their parents and teachers work together. This partnership agreement sets out the ways in which the school, parents and children can work together.

School will

- Ensure that your child is well taught and encouraged to do his/her best

- Provide a library book, a reading book, a learning log and other home learning activities which will be changed regularly
- Reward your child for good effort and behaviour
- Let you know if we have any concerns about your child and do our best to help
- Send home an annual report and hold two parent's evenings a year to discuss your child's progress and share information
- Provide a balanced curriculum which meets your child's needs
- Keep you informed of all school events for KS1

Children will

- Work hard and try my best at all times
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- Follow the school rules and always listen carefully to all the adults in school
 - Bring my book bag every day and take it home so that I can read to my parents regularly, and talk about and share my books with them
 - Ask for help when I need it
 - Take care of school property
 - Let a grown up know if something is worrying me
 - Complete my reading and my learning log on my own as much as possible
 - Wear my school uniform every day and make sure that I am in school on time daily and ready to learn

Parents will.....

- Make sure that our child comes to school in uniform, on time and ready to learn every day
- Encourage my child to always try his/her best
- Support the school rules and behaviour policy
- Become more actively involved in supporting our child's learning at home, with reading, the learning log and other home learning activities
- Praise our child for learning and behaving well
- Talk to the teacher if we have any concerns, needs or information to share
- Attend Key Stage 1 events in which our child is taking part
- Come to parents evenings and discussions about our child's progress
- Collect our child promptly at the end of the school day and notify the school if someone else is collecting.
