On Thursday 16th February 2023, the Eco-Ambassadors took part in an Arts Award Discover workshop alongside some children from Years Four and Five.



The day focused on raising awareness of climate change and how this relates to extinction. The workshop was run by Laura Barke who is a Project Officer at Leicester City Council. Laura was very impressed with the group and said they were very knowledgeable about current climate issues.

The workshop involved learning about a famous artist, taking part in a couple of different art-based activities and completing a final art



piece while considering some of the science behind climate change. The final art pieces were based on an endangered animal and were created by re-using old reading books that were no longer needed.

Year 6 Artwork

This week in Year 6 we looked at the artwork of Diego Rivera, who was a fresco artist inspired by the Mayan culture.



We used the Chromebooks to research his work and discovered that he would use natural materials to create his artwork.

Inspired by this, the pupils created their own painting tools out of leaves, twigs, wool and paper and experimented with their own mark making. The results were fantastic.

KS2 French

In Key Stage Two, all pupils take part in French lessons. Each unit is based around a particular theme.

This half term, the Year 3's theme is animals (Les Animaux), the Year 4's theme is fruit (Les Fruits) and the Year 5's theme is clothes (Les Vêtements). French is taught using Language Angels. To support their learning, each child in KS2 has a class login which they can use to access interactive French games and songs in school or at home.

Holiday Activities & Food Scheme

Clubzone are working with the local council for the Easter Holiday and Food (HAF) Scheme. Pupils who attend Braunstone Frith Primary will be prioritised but there are limited places. If you would like your child to attend please ensure you sign up, as it is a first come first serve basis

This is a very exciting opportunity and there are fully funded spaces for Free School Meal eligible pupils, if you choose to apply, the place is for 4 days on Monday 3rd, Tuesday 4th, Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th April, during the first week of the Easter Holiday. All activities and a lunch will be provided on each day.

If your child is not entitled to Free School Meals they can still attend and there will be a £20 charge for each day your child attends. This will include lunch. These paid spaces are also limited and are on a first come first serve basis.
