


Blogs about their Real LiFE Mission. A blog, short for weblog, is a frequently updated web page used for personal commentary or business content.

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Holiday Activities & Food Scheme

Clubszone are working with the local council for the Easter Holiday and Food (HAF) Scheme. Pupils who attend Braunstone Frith Primary will be prioritised but there are limited places. If you would like your child to attend please ensure you sign up, as it is a first come first serve basis

This is a very exciting opportunity and there are fully funded spaces for Free School Meal eligible pupils, if you choose to apply, the place is for 4 days on Monday 3rd, Tuesday 4th, Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th April, during the first week of the Easter Holiday. All activities and a lunch will be provided on each day.

If your child is not entitled to Free School Meals they can still attend and there will be a £20 charge for each day your child attends. This will include lunch. These paid spaces are also limited and are on a first come first serve basis.
