Message from Amelia Smith

Dear Parents/ Carers, It was a powerful act of remembrance last Friday to see all staff and children, both at Braunstone Frith and across all LiFE schools, dressed in orange to mark the 30th anniversary of the murder of Stephen Lawrence in an unprovoked racist attack.



Throughout the week children were learning more about who Stephen Lawrence was and exploring the theme of hopeful futures and the kind of world they would like to live in and what a world without discrimination might look like. Over the past couple of years children at Braunstone Frith have engaged in our REAL LIFE curriculum. Many of you will have had opportunities to see the outcome of these missions. Last term we had mission outcomes for We Are Conservationists and We Are Arborists. An early REAL LiFE project, in fact one of the first, was the mission to improve traffic on Tatlow Road. The children

achieved a huge amount by meeting with local councillors, our local MP and making contact with the bus companies. Traffic has improved dramatically BUT in recent weeks we have seen the return of some of the thoughtless behaviour. The children at Braunstone Frith say 'Please don't put our lives at risk'.

- Don't stop, get out of the car or let children get out of the car on the zigzags
- Don't stop and let children out in the middle of the road. It is dangerous.

This weekend will see celebrations to mark the coronation of King Charles. Lots of you joined your children in school on Wednesday afternoon for some red, white and blue activities. It's been lovely to see all the children take part in wearing red, white and blue to mark the occasion. And finally... next week sees our Year 6 children take their SATs tests. They have been well prepared, all we ask is that they try their best and we know they will do a cracking job. Come on Year 6!
