

Dear Parents and Carers,

During the Autumn term, I wrote to you to explain the guidance for **Relationships, Health and Sex Education** that became statutory for all primary schools from September 2020. I invited all parents to online meetings where I explained how we implement these in our school. Since 2020, in order to adapt to an ever changing world, we have introduced elements of Sex Education earlier into our PSHE curriculum and would like to share the resources and lessons that we use to deliver this area of the curriculum with you. We will be teaching these lessons after half term.

We understand that parents and carers are the main educators for children on many of these matters. With this in mind, we would like to invite you to attend the following information sharing session on Thursday 25th May 2 - 2.45pm.

During this session, we will take you through what we will be teaching in the lessons and show you any resources including videos that we will use to teach the children. You will be given the opportunity to ask any questions you may have about this. We believe that it is important for all children to take part in this vital learning. It is natural to feel uncomfortable about this issue however children can pick up myths and tall tales from the playground, leading to worrying misconceptions. These lessons are designed to ensure that your children have the correct information and are taught in an age appropriate manner. We would urge you to attend one of these meetings where your concerns, worries and questions can be addressed.
