Message from Naomi Grant

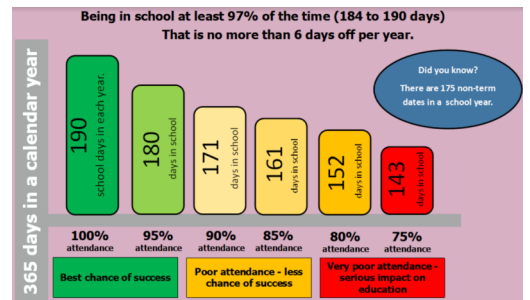

We have a few dates for the diary which we will share with you later in the newsletter. We are always looking for ways to get parents into school so we're trialling a few new sorts of open

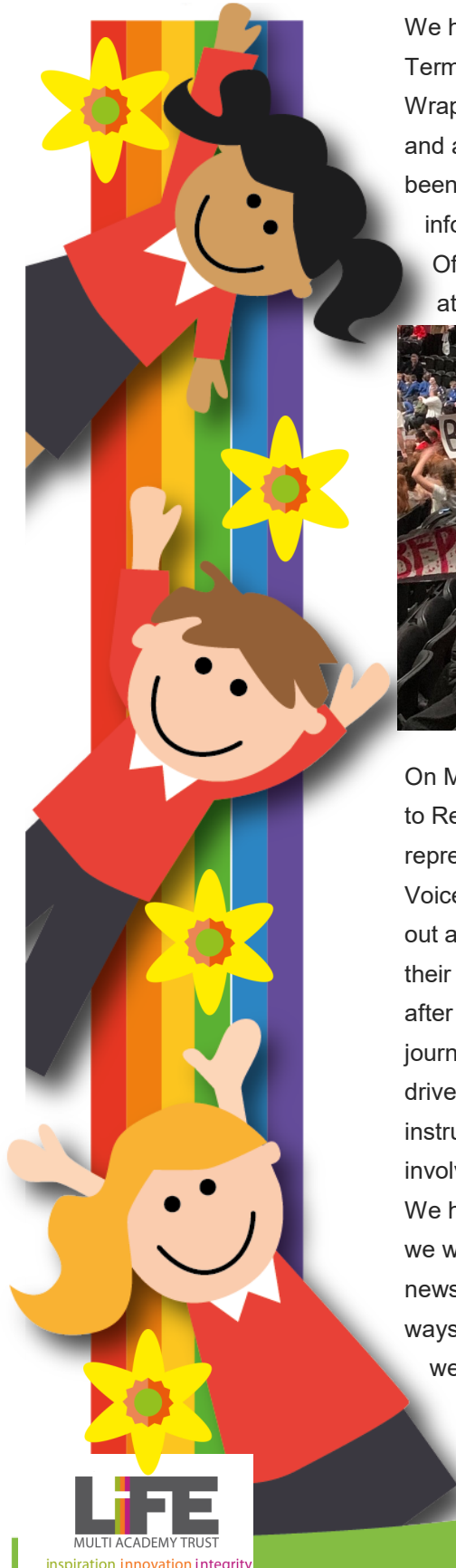
mornings and afternoons. Parents' evening is coming up on 14th and 15th February and we are looking forward to seeing you all in school then too.
