Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to remind you of our uniform expectations so that you are prepared for after the summer holidays. This term we have noticed that standards of uniform have gradually decreased. We understand that there were shortages in some shops and/or you did not want to buy new uniform this side of the summer. However, once we return to school after the summer holidays for the Autumn Term, the uniform expectations will be much tighter and we will insist that pupils are dressed in line with our uniform policy. With this in mind, please ensure that you purchase the correct uniform over the summer holidays.

An expectation of being a pupil at Braunstone Frith Primary Academy includes wearing our school uniform. The rationale behind school uniform is that it makes all pupils part of the wider CREW and feel like they belong. It is proven that pupils behave better when in school uniform. When children are in uniform, they understand much better that they need to follow the rules, as everyone else does. Unfortunately, it is common for children not in uniform to not follow the rules. Having an expectation for wearing the correct uniform also prepares pupils for secondary school.

The school uniform consists of:

- Red jumper or cardigan
- White shirt, blouse or polo shirt (red polo shirts are also acceptable)
- Black or grey trousers, pinafore or skirt (skirts should be knee-length)
- Black or grey school shorts in the summer
- Red gingham dresses in summer
- A small red or white bow (max width/length 5 cm)
- Plain stud earrings or small hoops
- Plain black shoes
- Plain grey, white or black socks

We have spare uniform in school in our family hub. If you have any spare uniform that you would like to donate, it would be greatly appreciated. Please leave it at the office. Equally, if you would like to see if there are any suitable items for your family, you are welcome to come and collect some. Please come to the office and we will direct you.

Please can I also remind you that children are only allowed to drink water throughout the school day. Juice is allowed with a packed lunch but not during lessons. Prime and other energy drinks are not allowed in school and Prime bottles must not be used to bring water.
