Dear Parents/Carers,

The next couple of weeks are very busy in school so I am writing to you with all the dates for your diary.



On Monday 11th November, it is Remembrance Day which we will be observing as a whole school at 11am. If your child is part of an organisation, such as Brownies or Scouts, they may bring their Brownie or Scout uniform to wear at our Remembrance Day Service.
