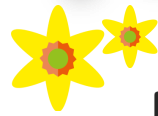

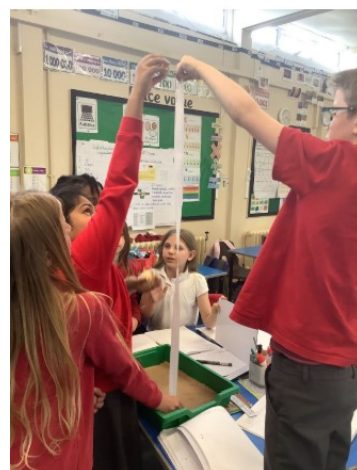
## Shirt Sponsors
