

Google Meet Help for Parents and Carers



What is Google Meet?

Google Meet enables our teachers to create online lessons, or meetings. Teachers can deliver their lesson content live, sharing their electronic resources on screen and communicating with students over video and chat. It is the closest thing to a classroom environment.

Are all lessons delivered via Google Meet?

No, our blended learning approach means that students will access and experience some live lessons, some pre-recorded and some independent learning tasks.

How do students know if a lesson is live?

All of the day's content for students is posted on their subject's Google Classroom streams in the morning by 9am. Students should check each subject's Google Classroom page at the very start of each lesson, following their school timetable. If a live lesson is scheduled, it will appear as a Class video meeting invitation, as shown below. All students need to do is click on this and enter the Meet.

How can students turn off their cameras and mics?

Students have the ability to turn off their own camera and mic by clicking the icons at the bottom of the Meet room.

What happens if there's an issue with technology?

First, we recommend leaving the Meet and then rejoining. If the problem persists, students should let their teachers know and catch up on the lesson at a later time using the recording.



What happens if the Google Meet is empty?

Sometimes it's necessary for teachers to change the link for the Meet. If a live lesson is planned but the teacher is not in the Meet room, students should leave the room, refresh their page and then try to re-enter.
