Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 10 students will soon be completing a week of mock examinations, commencing on Monday 25th April - straight after the Easter holidays. This week of assessments will provide our Year 10s with their first authentic experience of revising for and completing exam papers. Mocks also provide teachers with greater understanding of where individual students are in their journey towards achieving their potential, helping them to identify gaps in both knowledge and skills. It is important that students approach them seriously and feel prepared to demonstrate their best work.

In the past few weeks, all students have attended an assembly where guidance on the importance of revision and developing study habits has been given. During PSHCE time, students have focused on the creation of study timetables to structure their revision during evenings and weekends, as well as on the use of the 'Pomodoro' method of building revision around regular breaks. They have also explored how to create more effective flashcards and use them to self-test. Further tips can be found on our school website in our Effective Learning Strategies section.

With 6 weeks to go until mock exams begin, we are asking you as parents and carers to support us in ensuring that students prepare adequately and sensibly. Experience tells us that it really helps when parents:

- know the details of the exams for each subject as well as the revision guidance that has been given by teachers (please see the attached table)
- help to create the time and environment for dedicated study for example, you might support your child in making and sticking to a revision timetable with weekly study time for each subject planned out
- support children to work independently on their revision for a minimum of two hours each day, making use of the resources provided by their teachers (now including the brilliant GCSEPod!)

Students will receive their individual timetables, giving details of specific days, times and seating arrangements in due course. For now, if you have any questions then please do not hesitate to contact us. You should get in touch with your child's tutor or subject teacher in the first instance, depending on the nature of your query.

We are immensely proud of the commitment already being shown by our Year 10 students and wish them the best of luck over the coming weeks.

Prioritise your revision looking at Christian Beliefs and Practices though as we have only just completed your themes.
Music	Content from 1MU0/03	Edexcel	1 hour	Revise Bach, Purcell, Queen, Wicked, Star Wars and Release, ensuring that you know what the time signatures, keys, instrumentation and main structural features are for each piece. Remember to revise the musical terminology which relates to vocal music as well as the standard notational terms for lengths of note, texture, clefs and dynamics.
