


English Language	<p>English Language Paper 1 <i>Explorations in Creative Reading and Writing</i></p> <p>English Language Paper 2 <i>Writers' Viewpoints and Perspectives</i></p>	AQA	<p>Since September all students have been working through weekly revision homeworks (all classes have been set the same). By now, all GCSEPods on Paper 1 and Paper 2 should have been watched and notes made and several practice questions completed. To be successful in the summer, students should now:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give 100% in English lessons and complete all homework tasks • Check that they have watched all GCSEPods on English Language and made revision notes (e.g. mind-maps / Cornell notes) - the homework booklets can be found on Google Classroom • Watch Mr Bruff's YouTube videos and make notes on the top tips for each paper and question • Complete past papers (teachers can provide these and they can also be found on Google Classroom and the AQA website) • Attend any intervention they are invited to - including Easter sessions where possible.
English Literature	<p>English Literature Paper 1: <i>Macbeth and A Christmas Carol</i></p> <p>English Literature Paper 2: <i>An Inspector Calls, Power and Conflict Poetry and Unseen Poetry</i></p>	AQA	<p>Again, weekly revision tasks have focused on all four components of the Eng Lit course. By now, all GCSEPods on <i>Macbeth, A Christmas Carol, An Inspector Calls, the 15 Power and Conflict poems and Unseen Poetry</i> should have been watched and notes made. To be successful in the summer, students should now:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give 100% in English lessons and complete all remaining homework tasks • Attend any intervention they are invited to • Check they have made revision notes (mind-map / Cornell notes) on all texts that we've studied • Create flash cards for each text / poem, focusing on the plot, key characters, key quotations, language and structural points and key context • Complete past papers (teachers can provide these and mock questions have been added to Google Classroom) • Catch up on any poems / texts missed due to absence by using their own revision guides or the resources on Google Classroom / GCSEPod / YouTube (Mr Bruff) • For extra knowledge, students can watch Mr Bruff's YouTube videos and make notes on the top tips - he has videos for each of the texts and poems • Students can also use the following revision website to recap knowledge of texts and poems: https://www.physicsandmathstutor.com/english-revision/gcse-aqa/

Chunk your revision. • Exam skills - use the past papers and revision questions in your classrooms and practise your technique. Answer a range of questions from 2-9 marks.

Remember to sequentially number each task and record the number on the revision and your tracker. If you need a spare you can get one from your teacher. Remember to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plug any gaps in your knowledge first. • Then master the content by <u>creating</u> mind maps/reduced notes. • From these start to make revision cards to test yourself with. • Then you can start to try some practice questions - but only when you have mastered the content. Knowledge Booster Booklets: continue working through these for EEE and Germany, use the answer document to mark your work. Exam skills - in your red book you have advice on how to answer each question, also there is the revision folder shared with you on Google Drive which also contains 'how to answer' video lessons.
