# **BEYOND THE CLASSROOM**

In addition to our broad curriculum offer, we believe our enrichment programme is second to none.

At the heart of this provision is our Redmoor Enrichment Course (REC) which takes place in late June every year and provides Key Stage 3 students with a week of fantastic activities and opportunities that include sport, travel, culture, animals, the Arts and much more. During this week, our Year 10 students are engaged with valuable work experience placements as part of their preparation for Post 16 destinations and choices.

This is supported by our extra-curricular activities which run after school and at lunch. In addition to the traditional sporting, drama and music opportunities, we also offer accredited courses valued by employers and further education providers, including the Duke of Edinburgh Award and Sports Leaders Award.
