<u>Academic Reading at Redmoor</u>

- 1. Texts are printed for students and what the text looks like is carefully considered.
- 2. Teachers read the text aloud with pace and emphasis.
- 3. Teachers live model active reading strategies.
- 4. Students are supported to understand tricky or unfamiliar vocabulary (e.g. through live modelling / a glossary / dictionary use).
- 5. Accompanying tasks make the academic reading meaningful. (e.g. through summary questions, comprehension questions, group discussion).

Academic Reading at Redmoor

- 1. Ensure you have a printed copy of the text from your teacher.
- 2. Follow along as your teacher reads the text aloud.
- 3. Actively read over the text again. Could you highlight, underline, summarise?
- 4. Identify any unfamiliar or tricky vocabulary. How could find out the definition?
- 5. Complete any follow up activity.
