Dear Parent/Carer.

We will be holding a Year 8 'Settling In' Tutor Evening on **Tuesday 8th October** 2024 from 3:30pm until 6:30pm. This provides an opportunity for you to attend a short meeting <u>in school</u> with your child's form tutor to discuss how your child has settled into the new academic year.

Throughout your child's time at Redmoor Academy we have really focused on what 'good enough' effort looks like - as well as on the Redmoor DNA's seven character traits that we expect our students to demonstrate in the classroom and beyond. Having the right attitude to learning is essential and so far this term we have been incredibly impressed with Year 8 for returning to school with a very good work ethic, once again doing their best to meet our high expectations.

At the Tutor Evening, your child's tutor will focus very much on your child's effort and attitude and will have a 'Settling In' report to talk through with you. This will contain four attitude to learning scores for each subject, with subject teachers grading your child's effort with classwork and homework, as well as their behaviour and organisation, between A and D. Where a grade C or D is given, there will be a comment explaining the reason and what the student needs to do to improve as they move forward into the academic year. There will, of course, be an opportunity later in the academic year to speak with subject teachers in more detail - and a full email directory for all teaching staff can be found on our school website if you have any queries at this early stage in the year.

The Tutor Evening is the right time to raise any queries or concerns you may have about your child and to discuss their general happiness and wellbeing. In addition to your child's tutor, Mrs Atkinson (Year 8 Manager) and Miss Clements (Assistant Year Manager) will be present, should you wish to speak with them, or members of our SEND department, appointments are bookable via SchoolCloud. The Pupil Premium team will also be available throughout the evening, with no appointment necessary.

Even though this is an in-school event, appointment times for tutors will be booked via the SchoolCloud system, with **booking opening on Tuesday 24th September.** Appointment times can be booked via this link, which you will also find on the school website home page: https://redmooracademy.schoolcloud.co.uk
