The overall aims of our catch-up premium strategy is to raise the attainment of all pupils to close the gap created by COVID-19 school closures

Our catch-up priorities:

- 1. Targeted support identify students for key intervention groups
- 2. English, Maths and Science use the National Tutoring Programme to provide additional support to some of our more disadvantaged students
- 3. Wider strategies

Our catch-up priorities are:

• Identifying and targeting gaps in students' knowledge. Attainment data from the Autumn term has enabled teachers to identify such gaps. This has also been supported by data collected from formative assessments.

- Enabling and supporting students to access materials, remote lessons and partake in learning. Identifying a cohort of students who will benefit from small group tuition.
- Support and address student wellbeing through curriculum and pastoral roles.
