#### Sharing our Stories as we go...










This week we have been learning about Italy with it being multicultural week. This also fits in with our expedition because it's allowed us to explore the country in more detail and discover things such as their food and language.





We have Nurse Welburn come into school this week and share her experiences of being a nurse. Nurse Welburn is an expert and we loved being able to learn from her.




#### The Roman Rampage by Charlie

What a little superstar!




