#### Sharing our Stories as we go...





It is extremely important that children are reading daily at home.

### Super shadow puppets!

We wanted to find out what happened when we moved the object closer or further away from the light source. We found out that when the object is closer to the light source, the shadow gets bigger. When the object is moved further away from the light source, the shadow gets smaller.


