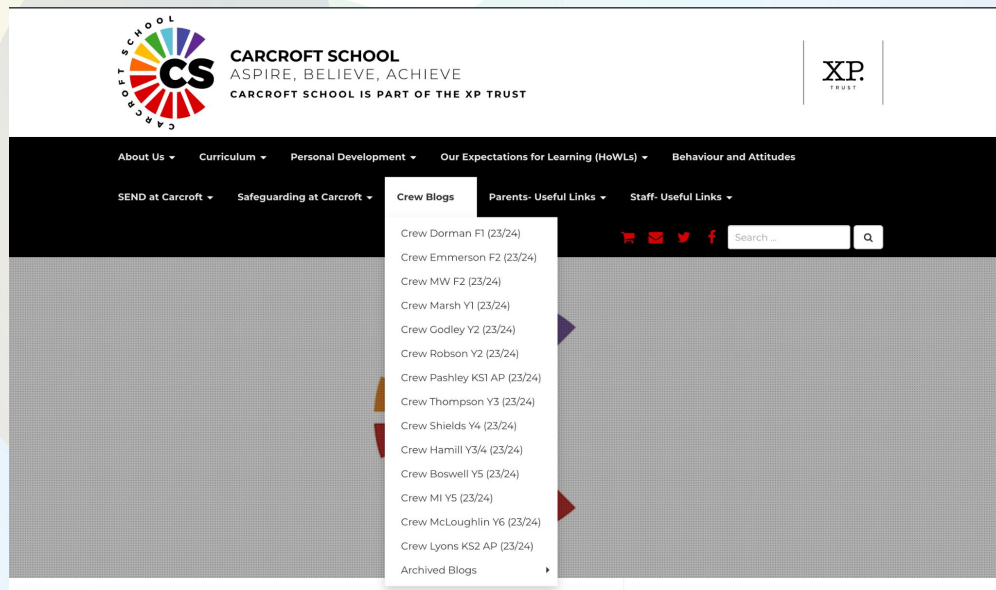

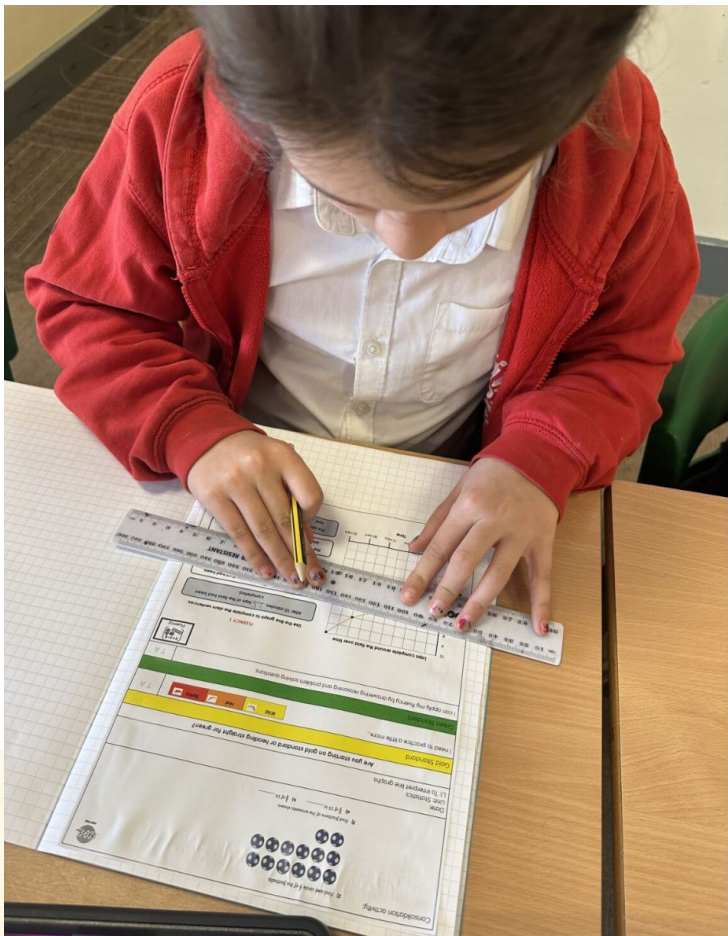
Crew MI continue to build on their fluency through echo reading and partner reading.
