Sharing our Stories as we go...



Children must bring their book bag into school every day so that their reads can be checked and in case their book gets changed.


It is extremely important that children are reading daily at home.








our text marking skills to improve pace when re-reading.





The Sun rotates on its axis.




UKS2 have started to understand the science behind day and night, and why seasons exist!
