Sharing our Stories as we go...



Please can we ask that children are reading their book at home for 10 minutes per day and at least 3 x per week/ ideally 4 times a week.





Crew Hamill have began a new book... they travelled to the blue room to immerse ourselves into a similar situation – a confined, dark space with the lights of the milky way and stars.
















