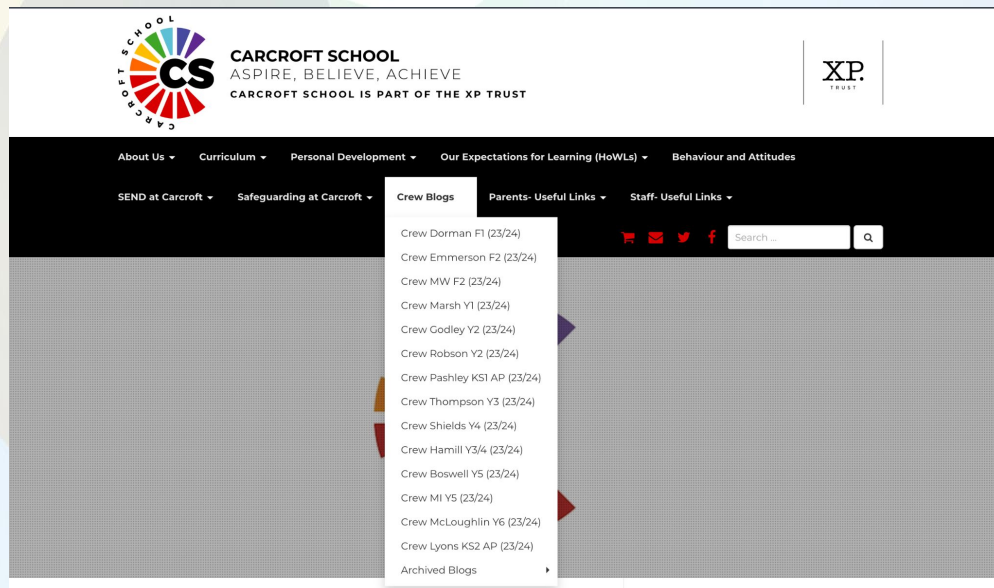

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Children must bring their book bag into school every day so that their reads can be checked and in case their book gets changed.

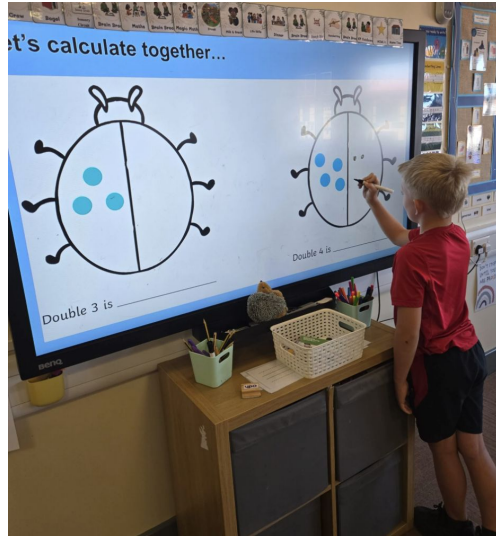
It is extremely important that children are reading daily at home.

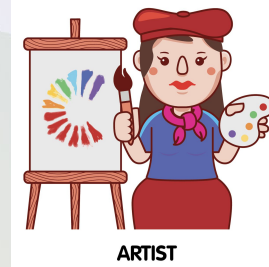
