<ul> <li>Exploring and developing ideas (ongoing)</li> <li>Record and explore ideas from first hand observation, experience and imagination.</li> <li>Ask and answer questions about the starting points for their work and the processes they have used. Develop their ideas.</li> <li>Explore the differences and similarities within the work of artists, craftspeople and designers in different times and cultures.</li> </ul>			<ul> <li>Evaluating and developing work (ongoing)</li> <li>Review what they and others have done and say what they think and feel about it. E.g. Annotate sketchbook</li> <li>Identify what they might change in their current work or develop in their future work.</li> <li>Annotate work in sketchbook.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Layer different media, e.g. crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal and ballpoint.</li> <li>Understand the basic use of a sketchbook and work out ideas for drawings.</li> <li>Draw for a sustained period of time from the figure and real objects, including single and grouped objects.</li> <li>Experiment with the visual elements; line, shape, pattern and colour.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Mix a range of secondary colours, shades and tones.</li> <li>Experiment with tools and techniques, inc. layering, mixing media, scraping through etc.</li> <li>Name different types of paint and their properties.</li> <li>Work on a range of scales e.g. large brush on large paper etc.</li> <li>Mix and match colours using artefacts and objects.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use a variety of techniques, inc. carbon printing, relief, press and fabric printing and rubbings.</li> <li>Design patterns of increasing complexity and repetition.</li> <li>Print using a variety of materials, objects and techniques.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use a variety of techniques, inc. weaving, French knitting, tie-dyeing, fabric crayons and wax or oil resist, appliqué and embroidery.</li> <li>Create textured collages from a variety of media.</li> <li>Make a simple mosaic.</li> <li>Stitch, knot and use other manipulative skills.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Manipulate clay for a variety of purposes, inc. thumb pots, simple coil pots and models.</li> <li>Build a textured relief tile.</li> <li>Understand the safety and basic care of materials and tools. Experiment with, construct and join recycled, natural and manmade materials more confidently.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Explore ideas using digital sources e.g. Internet, CD-ROMs</li> <li>Record visual information using digital cameras and recorders</li> <li>Use a simple graphics package to create images and effects with lines by changing the size of brushes in response to ideas</li> <li>Use eraser, shape and fill tools</li> <li>Use basic selecting and cropping tools</li> </ul>
