RRSA GOLD UPDATE

Last week we had our Gold Rights Respecting School visit. Whilst at this point we are not allowed to officially share the outcome of this, I would like to say how proud it made us all of the school and our amazing pupils. On the day, the assessor met with members of the Leadership Team, a selection of staff and parents and a number of pupil groups.

The highlights shared by her included the following:

- It is clear that the school has been grown with Rights at its heart
- Pupils' Rights are embedded from the Early Years upwards
- There is a clear celebration of diversity in the school
- Inclusion is a clear strength throughout the school
- The children talked 'beautifully' about their work with charities and especially CAFT
- Children feel listened to by adults in school

Overall it was a very proud experience for us all and a lovely opportunity to celebrate our Rights Respecting approach at CHPS.
