In 2018, Cheadle Hulme Primary opened with the intention of having children's rights at the heart of the education and daily experiences we provide for our pupils. Since then, the community has worked hard to embed this ethos both into the curriculum we teach and in the environment we have strived to establish.

As you will know, prior to the break we had an assessment visit and I am delighted to share that the outcome of this is that we have been awarded Rights Respecting Gold status! This is highest level a school can achieve in this programme and is a reflection of the dedication, care and commitment of the CHPS team over many years, the support of the parental community and most importantly of course, the respect shown by our pupils each and every day both in the way they conduct themselves in school and in their outlook and concern for the world outside our gates.

As a little insight into its content in the meantime, the following quotes captured on the assessment day encapsulate it well:
