SPORTS DAY

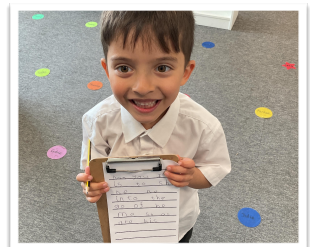
We are pleased to invite parents to join us for our Sports Day on Tuesday 23rd June which will take place on the grounds of Laurus Cheadle Hulme at the following times:
