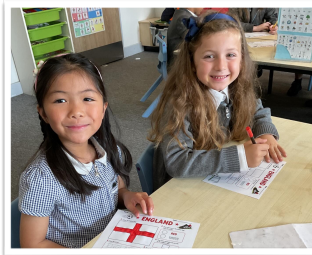


PTA SUMMER FAIR
