Important Changes to Breakfast Club from September

We're writing to let you know about some important changes to our breakfast club provision from September. Currently, we're experiencing significant challenges with families not booking or paying for breakfast club in advance, which is making it very difficult for us to plan staffing appropriately. To ensure we can continue to offer a high-quality service, we're introducing a new structure from September:

Paid Breakfast Club (7:45am – 8:30am): This session will cost £5 and must be booked and must be paid for in advance. **Children will not be able to attend if this is not booked and paid for in advance.**

Free Breakfast Club (8:30am – 9:00am): We're delighted to be part of the government's free breakfast club programme, which means all children can access a free breakfast club from 8:30am. From 8:30am to 8:40am, children can enter through the front door and will remain in school, from 8.45 the children will come through the main door as normal and receive their breakfast in class. As part of this programme, we'll be providing healthy breakfast options including wholemeal bread and cereals, fresh fruit, low-fat dairy products, and healthy spreads. This provision is designed to ensure every child starts their day ready to learn.

We hope these changes will provide you with greater flexibility whilst ensuring we can staff our provision safely and effectively. More details about booking the paid session will follow in the coming weeks.

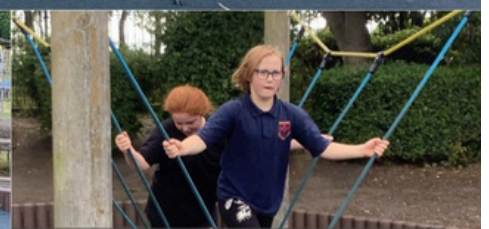
A huge thank you to all that attended our summer fayre. We raised an incredible £940. This money will go towards enrichment opportunities for the children in school.
