



Homework


At Corpus Christi we value the extra time that goes into completing homework and we have worked together to develop a homework system that is consistent and manageable for our children and families.

Every child will receive maths and spelling homework each week. The spellings given will be closely matched to words which the pupils will be learning about or using in class. The maths homework will also be linked closely to work which the children have been completing within the maths lessons.

As well as the weekly homework the children will be given a cross curricular sheet each half term. This sheet will have examples and ideas of some creative ideas linked to our wider curriculum topics. The children are able to select from these examples or

think of their own ideas. They will be rewarded for completing one of their extra tasks by receiving 5 points on Dojo and they are able to share their work with the rest of the class.

This sheet lasts the whole half term. The children are able to choose which ones they want to do, do them all or think of their own creative ideas.

RE - Parables and Miracles.	Consider one of the miracles that you know about already. The Wedding at Cana, Feeding of the 5000 and others too. Can you create a picture to represent what happened in the <u>story</u> .				
English.	In English we are going to be learning about writing stories. Think about a story that you would like to write. Who would be in your story? Where would your story take place? What exciting thing might happen? Talk about your story with someone at home and have a go at writing your story. You should use capital letters and full stops and also have a go at using interesting adjectives.				
Maths	In Maths we are going to be continuing to add and subtract numbers. Use number lines or the column method to add and subtract numbers. (I will add some videos on Dojo to help you.				
History	This half term we are going to be learning about Florence Nightingale and learning about how she was a nurse during Queen Victoria's reign. Can you make a model of a hospital and what it would have been like for Florence? Could you set up your own toy hospital and send me a picture on Dojo? Consider the differences between hospitals now and hospitals in Florence's time.
