Humanities

By the end of Key Stage 1, all pupils will:

- ★ Develop their enquiry skills by carefully looking at photos and artefacts.
- ★ Know a range of significant people throughout history and understand how their actions had an effect nationally and internationally.
- ★ Use and interpret a timeline with confidence and they will know how the events that they've learnt about contribute to a coherent understanding of the past.
- ★ Use maps, globes and atlases to name and locate the UK, as well as the world's oceans and continents.
- ★ Use basic geographical vocabulary with confidence to refer to physical and human geographical features.
- ★ Study a small area of another country and learn about its culture, physical features and then compare it to a small area of the UK.

Developing cultural capital in humanities:

- ★ Pupils will handle and talk about a range of artefacts and historical photographs in lessons. .
- ★ Use of skills in a cross curricular way e.g. writing a report about Ernest Shackleton's expedition in English.
- ★ Pupils will explore and create maps of their local area.
- ★ Pupils will talk positively about living in Luton and be able to talk about how Lutonians live now and in the past.
