Music

By the end of Key Stage 1, all pupils will:

- ★ Sing songs, rhymes and chants with enthusiasm.
- ★ Show an understanding of singing in around.
- ★ Create simple rhythms based on word patterns.
- ★ Be confident describing the moods and emotional and visual pictures they see and hear when listening to music.
- ★ Play an untuned percussion instrument with a rhythmic awareness, creating simple rhythms based on word patterns and understanding how to layer patterns to compose a rhythm composition.
- ★ Be aware of the interrelated dimensions of music: pitch, dynamics, tempo and timbre.

Developing cultural capital in Music:

- ★ Pupils will use a range of musical instruments such as boom whackers.
- ★ Pupils will perform in front of an audience.
- ★ Pupils will experience live music from different genres and cultures.
- ★ Artist of the Week will allow children experience different styles and genres of music and critique these based on their personal tastes.
