

Major Line Closure

Saturday 16 - Friday 29 July St James - Tynemouth

Why are we closing the line?

The Tanners Bank bridge located between Tynemouth and North Shields Metro stations is to be completely removed and an entirely new bridge constructed in its place.

The replacement is possible as the majority of the funding has come from the Department for Transport and assistance from North Tyneside Council.

During the line closure we'll also be carrying out vegetation and overhead power line work.

How will it affect your journey?


No trains can operate between St James and Tynemouth in either direction for the fourteen days the work takes place.

Service between St James and Tynemouth will return on Saturday 30 July. When the line is closed you'll still be able to make your journey as selected bus services will be accepting Metro tickets and passes.

Trains will continue to run between:

- Tynemouth and South Shields (via Whitley Bay)
- South Shields and Tynemouth (via Whitley Bay)
- · Airport and South Hylton
- South Hylton and Airport

Some train times may be different to the usual timetable so please check before travelling by using the Live Travel Map at **nexus.org.uk** or by calling 0191 20 20 747 (lines are open Monday-Friday, 9.00am-5.00pm).

Plan your journey in advance

Journey times on the buses will be longer than on Metro, so please plan ahead and remember to leave extra time for travel, especially if transferring between different modes of transport.

Please note, some buses will not run as early or as late as Metro trains would have.

Impact on neighbours

A compound near Chillingham Road station and one adjacent to Tanners Bank on Tynemouth Road, will be used to store materials and equipment leading up to and during the closure.

Residents close to the Metro line or compound area may experience work near their home and an increase in activity by our teams. However noise will be kept to a minimum.

Road and footpath closures

Tanners Bank will be closed under the Metro bridge from 20 June to 12 August. There will be no access to road vehicles or pedestrians for the eight weeks.

Tynemouth Road next to the bridge will be closed to all road vehicles for two weeks, 16 July to 29 July 2022 (access to pedestrians and cyclists will be possible).

Diversion signage will be in place.
