Google Classroom is a free service (part of your Google account) that helps students and teachers organise assignments, boost collaboration, and foster better communication.



It allows you to develop and deliver interactive remote learning lessons to students.

Find out how to:

- Create a Classroom with students.
- Post to the stream.
- Add materials and create assignments.
- Oversee students completed assignments.

Google Forms is part of G Suite for Education and will help you work smarter. It's easy to use and one of the simplest ways to make resources, surveys, tests and quizzes. It even collects the answers or responses straight into a spreadsheet so you get instant results as they come in. You can summarise results at a glance with charts and graphs.



Find out how to:

- Create and analyse surveys in your mobile or web browser
- Set up quizzes for your students
- Assess topics with minimum fuss
- Use Google Forms to set and assess remote learning tasks
