Google Forms is part of G Suite for Education and will help you work smarter. It's easy to use and one of the simplest ways to make resources, surveys, tests and quizzes. It even collects the answers or responses straight into a spreadsheet so you get instant results as they come in. You can summarise results at a glance with charts and graphs.

A Jamboard is a digital interactive whiteboard developed by Google to work with Google Workspace. It is a collaborative space with options to draw, add pictures, shapes, sticky notes, and text. Students or colleagues can sketch out ideas, problem solve, or draw collaboratively and synchronously. Share your jams with collaborators.
