There are 6 modules to be covered in Year 12:

***Social Influence, Memory, Attachment, Approaches, Psychopathology and Research Methods.***

Your task is to research these key studies and prepare summaries on what was researched and discovered (150-200 words each).

In order to prepare your summaries, you will also need to research what is meant by ***ethical research***. To find this out, search ethics in psychology to learn about the different ethical concerns when conducting psychological research.

## KEY STUDIES TO RESEARCH

### **YOU MUST:**

- Asch (1951) – conformity
- Zimbardo (1973) – Stanford Prison Experiment
- Milgram (1963)-Obedience
- Lorenz (1935) – attachment
- Pavlov (1902) – conditioning

For each study summary, make sure you include:

- What was researched
- What did they find out
- What do the findings mean
- How *ethical* was the study

### **YOU SHOULD....**

- Research the multi-store model of memory AND working memory model: explain the different processes of the memory model. Draw this model and annotate the coding, capacity and duration of each store.

### **YOU COULD....**

- Research the different approaches in psychology: cognitive approach, biological approach, behavioural approach and the social learning theory. Explain the basic assumptions of these approaches and what research has been conducted to support their ideas?
