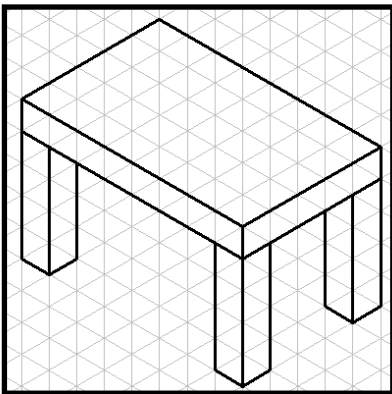


## **Design and technology—Year 8—Isometric Drawing**

Using the grid and the guide lines below draw an everyday item you could find at home.

An example has been completed for you.

<b>Success Criteria</b>		<b>Self</b>	<b>Parent/ Guardian</b>
<b>Drawing</b>	You have started and stopped all lines on an intersection.		
	You have used a ruler for every line.		
	You have drawn lightly in pencil in case you need to rub any lines out.		
	You have drawn directly on top of the grid for every line.		
	You have drawn your design accurately to ensure it is the correct shape with no missing lines.		
	You have applied fineliner accurately and pencil has been rubbed out.

### **Top Tips**

Remember there are no horizontal lines in isometric drawing.

Remember every line you draw has to be drawn directly over another grid line.
