This is a nationally recognised qualification, currently with the possibility of a full scholarship, to prepare delegates for senior leadership. Closing date for applications is **Tuesday 17th December**, to apply for a full scholarship. The programme requires four full days out of school and is based at St Mary's. The new reformed NPQSL is accredited by Leadership for the North East, L4NE and is designed to support you in becoming a highly effective senior leader with the skills, confidence and knowledge to contribute to the strategic development of your school.

The course covers the leadership behaviours demonstrated by the best school leaders - commitment, personal drive, collaboration, resilience, awareness, integrity and respect. A range of different study methods are incorporated eg. coaching, face to face CPD, structured reflection and online learning.

Who is it for?

NPQSL has been developed for leaders who are leading beyond a team with the responsibilities and accountabilities associated with a senior leadership role and for those middle leaders ambitious to achieve promotion eg. an experienced middle leader or a senior member of staff such as Teaching School Director.

NPQSL Costs:

The cost is £870, including final assessment. Please note - staff working in the Hexham and Newcastle Diocese or a priority area, eg. Northumberland, may be eligible for a full scholarship from the DfE. Optional 360 diagnostic, available at £60, would also be covered by a scholarship.
