


Issue 8

A Total Joy!



We are incredibly proud of Year 12 student Joy Eze, and all that she has achieved this year. Joy is a real sporting talent, and this year, she has gone from strength to strength. She has committed to a challenging and rigorous training programme over the course of the year, whilst also balancing the demands of her A-levels in Biology, Chemistry and Sociology. Bearing testimony to her incredible talent and hard work, in April, Joy received her first Great Britain selection. She was chosen to represent Great Britain under-20s at the Loughborough International event where she competed in the 100ms and the relay.

At the time Joy competed in Loughborough, she was 16 years old, and as such, she was one of the youngest members of the team. Joy had a brilliant competition. She progressed amazingly well in her races. She won her individual race, against athletes who were all older than her, with the fastest time of the day, running faster than all of the U23 and senior athletes. She also ran a European U20 championship qualifying standard of 11.65 with no wind to aid her performance. No other female sprinter at the meeting achieved this mark. She then joined the GB A-team, for the relay and won again! Joy's performance secured her a place in the GB team for the Championships in Estonia that is taking place this week. Joy has trained with the Gateshead Harriers for some time now, and her achievements really do reflect her hard-work, tenacity and determination to succeed.

Joy's coach is our Vice Chair of Governors, Mike Donnelly, and he, and the entire team at Gateshead Harriers, are absolutely delighted for her. Joy has had to selfisolate, in the run up to championships in Estonia as a precautionary measure, and making these sorts of personal sacrifices is never easy. We have everything crossed that Joy has a great run in Estonia, when representing Great Britain, and we are so very proud of everything she has achieved this year.




