## **GCSE Results Day: Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August**

I hope that you and your family are keeping well.

We are all looking forward to welcoming back our Year 11 students on GCSE Results Day, Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August. After such a disruptive and challenging year, it will be lovely to see Year 11 students celebrating their achievements at the end of Key Stage 4, before they move on to the next phase of their lives, either here at St Mary's or elsewhere.

The results will be issued in the Sports Hall, with students entering the building through the doors located at the far side of the building, near the tennis courts, and exiting the building through the doors near to the Main Entrance. Although restrictions across the country have been largely eased, we are very mindful of the extremely high Covid infection rates across the region at present. Therefore, we think that it is prudent to proceed with caution when planning the day. We are staggering the arrival of students on site according to tutor group. This is to limit the potential for congestion and ensure that there is always sufficient space within the Sports Hall. It will also be good for students to be with many familiar faces from their tutor group when they open their envelopes and see their grades for the first time.
