## **Re: Cinema Day – Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

I hope that this letter finds you well. We are currently planning a fun day of activities for Years 7-10 at the end of term, to reward students for their excellent efforts throughout this school year. For several years pre-COVID, the final Wednesday of the academic year was a day that we set aside to take students off site for a day of fun activities to celebrate their efforts during the academic year. We are delighted that we are able to return to having a 'Cinema Day' this year. Our 'Cinema Day' this year will take place on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

On this day, we plan on taking all Year 7-Year 10 students to the Vue Cinema in Gateshead to watch a recently released, age-appropriate film. All students should arrive at school at the usual time of no later than 8.40am on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July. Students can wear appropriate, non-school uniform on this day. Students will arrive at school and go to their Form Classes where they will participate in a fun, end of year quiz with their Form Tutor. Then, in a staggered manner, students will travel via Metro Train with their Form Tutor, other teachers and senior staff to the Vue Cinema in Gateshead. Upon arrival, students will be able to purchase any snacks/drinks if they wish. Students will then watch a film with their Year Group. Students will then travel back to school with staff on Metro Trains, with students then departing from school at the usual dismissal time. Therefore, on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July, all Year 7-Year 10 students will start and end school at the usual time.

We hope that all students will want to participate in the above event. Students may wish to bring a packed lunch that day that they can eat in the cinema if they would like, or they can bring a small amount of money to purchase their own snacks from the cinema. Those students who receive a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch. If any students do not want to go to the cinema, they will of course be able to stay in school.

The cost of the above trip, including one cinema ticket as well as transport costs on the Metro to and from the cinema is **£4 per student**. If you would like your child to attend the above cinema trip, please complete the EV3 consent form that can be accessed here via this link and then please pay the £4 electronically via the iPayment System. Please do contact your child's Head of Year if you would like to discuss any financial aspect of this trip.

**Therefore, if you would like your child to attend our 'Cinema Day' this year at Vue Cinema, Gateshead, please complete the above EV3 consent form and payment, via the link above and the iPayment website, by the latest of Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July. Your child will be unable to leave school on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July unless the above EV3 consent form and payment have been submitted.**

We are all really looking forward to this event and I am sure this day will prove to be a wonderful day for all students. Thank you for your continued support throughout this year.
