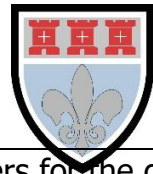




Year 13 Recommended Work in Independent Study Periods

Subject	Recommended Work
Art	Complete outstanding course work.
Biology	There are independent work books to complete which contain examination questions and mark schemes. The work books also contain other resources such as checklists.
Vocational Business	Complete outstanding course work.
Chemistry	<p>Complete the end of chapter tests, the end of module questions, kerboodle questions, multiple choice questions, purple questions and past paper. All mark schemes can be found with the questions.</p> <p>In addition, complete the revision booklets to make extra notes on the different topics.</p>
Vocational Childcare	Complete outstanding course work.
Computer Science	Review the different PowerPoints for the different topics and then answer the questions found in the tasks of the different topics.
Drama	<p>Answer practice exam questions and look at how to answer questions on live theatre.</p> <p>Review your understanding of machinal design.</p> <p>Review how to structure your essays.</p>
English Literature	<p>Complete the guided reading and essay questions for the different texts covered.</p> <p>Review the revision guides and knowledge organisers for all texts.</p> <p>Review the practice questions and the sample essay answers.</p>
English Language	<p>Look over the different lesson PowerPoints for the different topics in each course.</p> <p>Complete the revision booklets.</p>
Economics	<p>Follow the links to access and complete the revision booklets, examinations questions and the practice questions available.</p> <p>Watch the videos on the different YouTube channel to review the different topics.</p>





Film Studies	<p>Complete the knowledge organisers for the different sections of the course.</p> <p>Complete the study workbooks and fact sheets for the different pieces of media.</p>
Geography	<p>There are some revision notes for each topic, exam practice questions and examiner commentary for each topic then can highlight and pick out key strengths and what to avoid.
