<p>Accessories</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only one pair of stud earrings. No other piercings are allowed. This includes facial piercings. • Only one ring is allowed. • A wrist watch is allowed. • Plain, dark socks or plain, dark or natural tights only. • Socks must be ankle length. Knee high socks are not allowed. <p>Hairstyles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Neat, sensible hairstyles only. • No 'extreme' haircuts are allowed. • Natural hair colours only. • Plain, dark, discreet hairbands and hair accessories only. • A student who, for religious reasons, wears a head covering, must ensure that it is a dark colour. <p>Make-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make-up must be discreet and natural.
