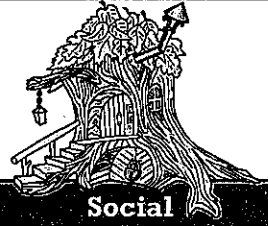


# Environmental Factors

<p><b>Physical</b>  <i>E.g. can afford good food and clothes to keep warm and healthy so less chance of getting ill.</i></p>	<p><b>Intellectual</b>  <i>E.g. can afford to go on holiday and experience and learn about different countries and cultures.</i></p>
<p><b>Emotional</b>  <i>E.g. Don't have to worry about paying bills</i></p>	<p><b>Social</b>  <i>E.g. can afford to join clubs so will meet lots of people.</i></p>
