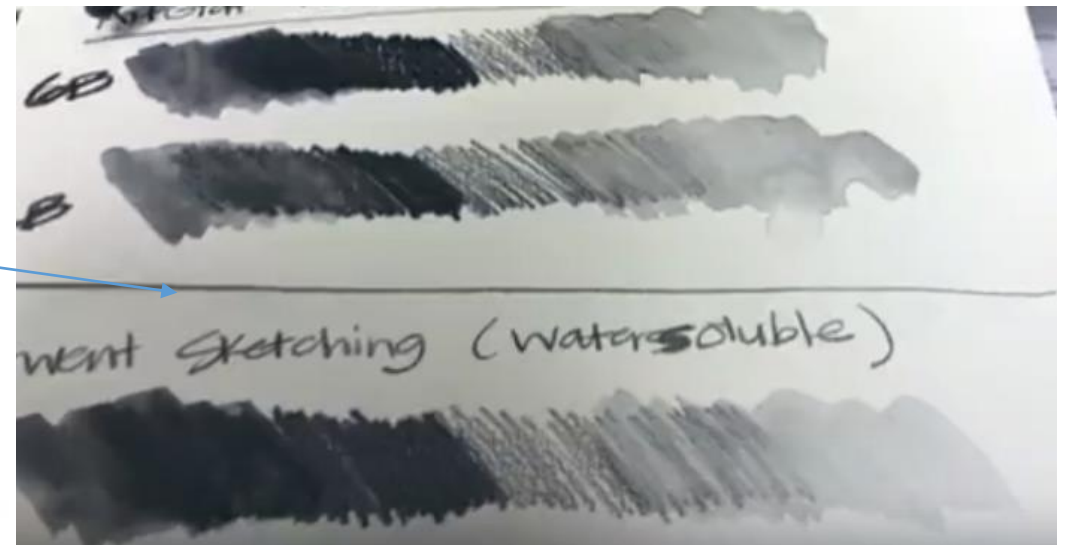
Drawing with graphite, water & watercolour

Use a graphite stick and water to create another one of your photographs. The water should stretch the graphite.

You can add a few washes of watercolour to your work for extra depth.

Use a mixture of dark, medium and light tones with white highlights.

Look at the examples on the next page, perhaps you could try an alternative material.



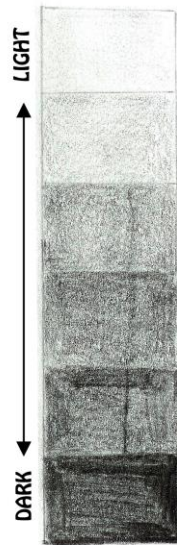
