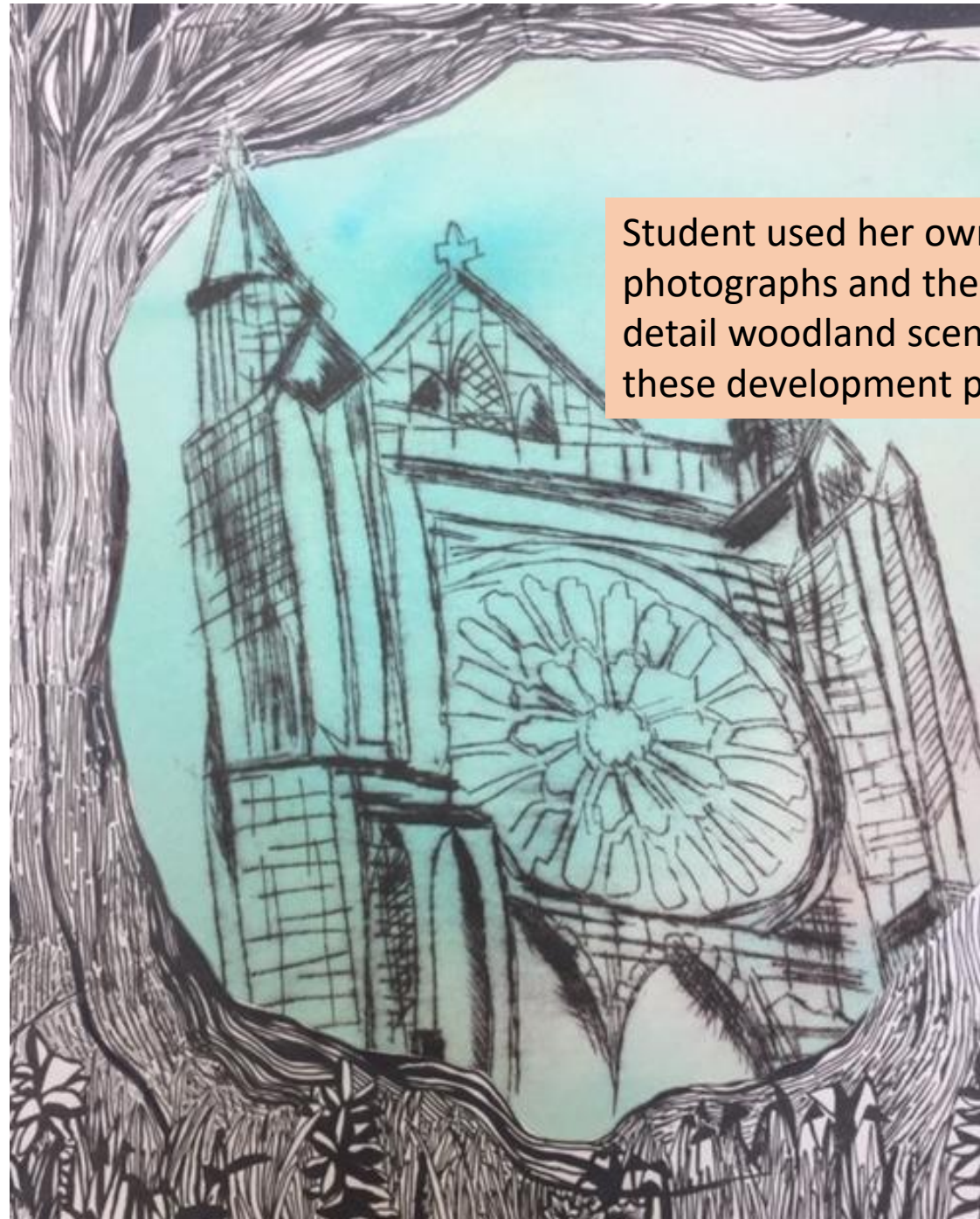

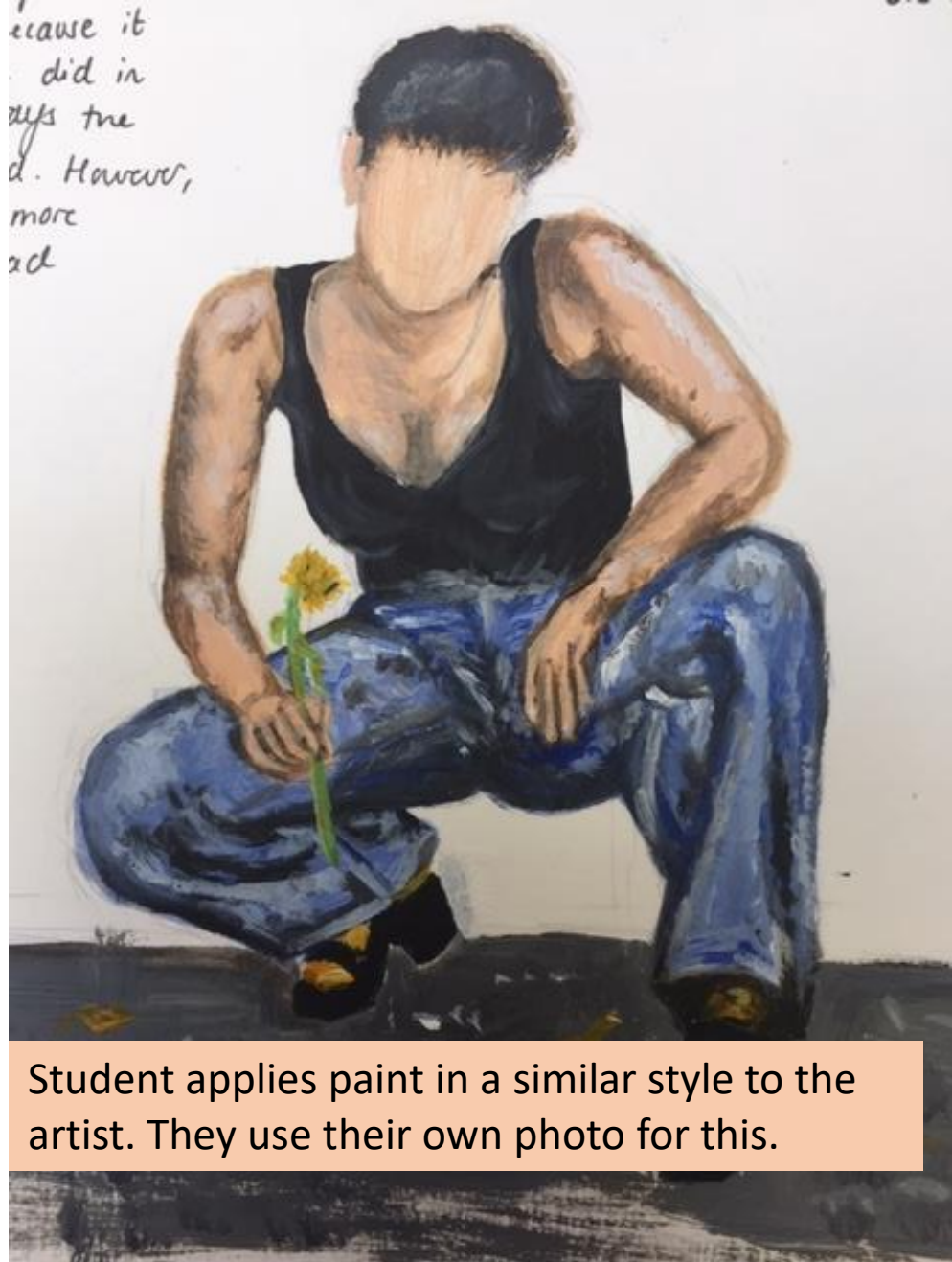


Student used their own images, but applied the artist's surreal colour palettes and exaggerated facial features

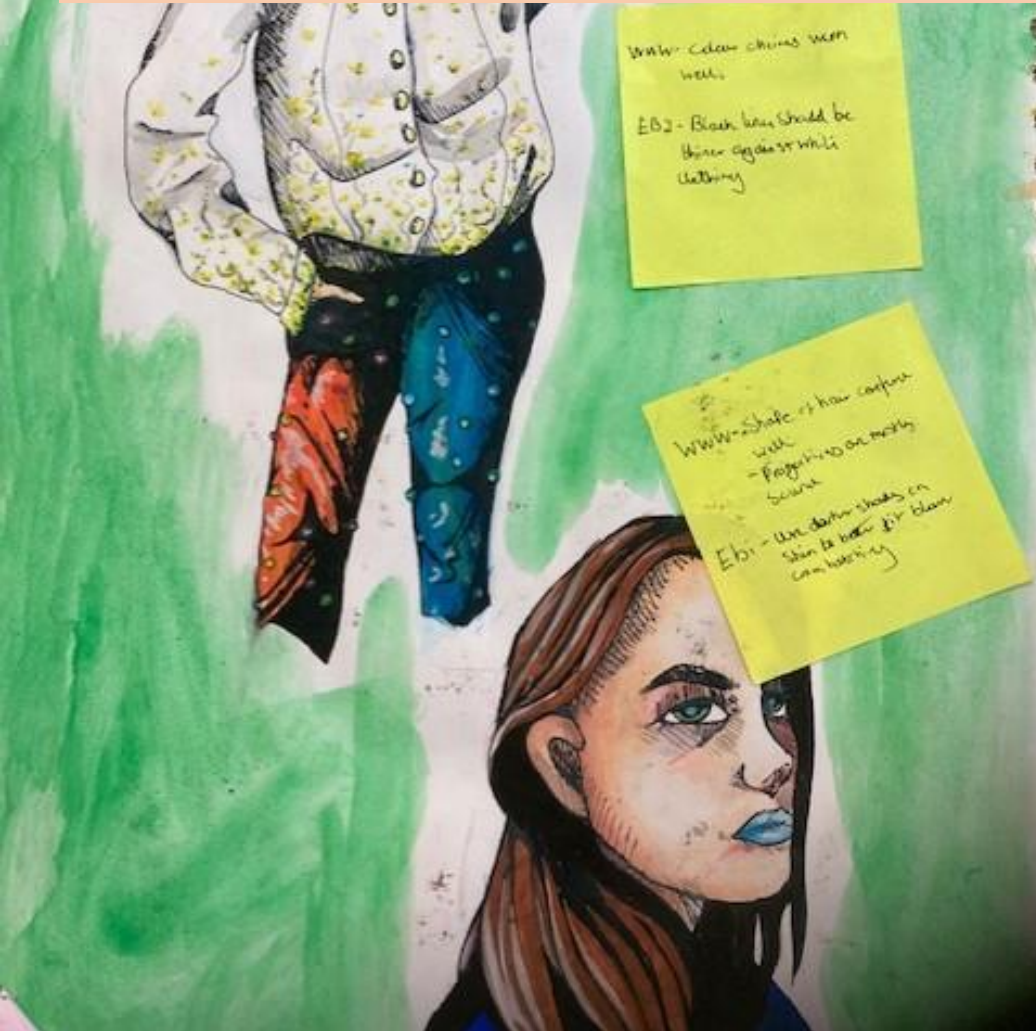

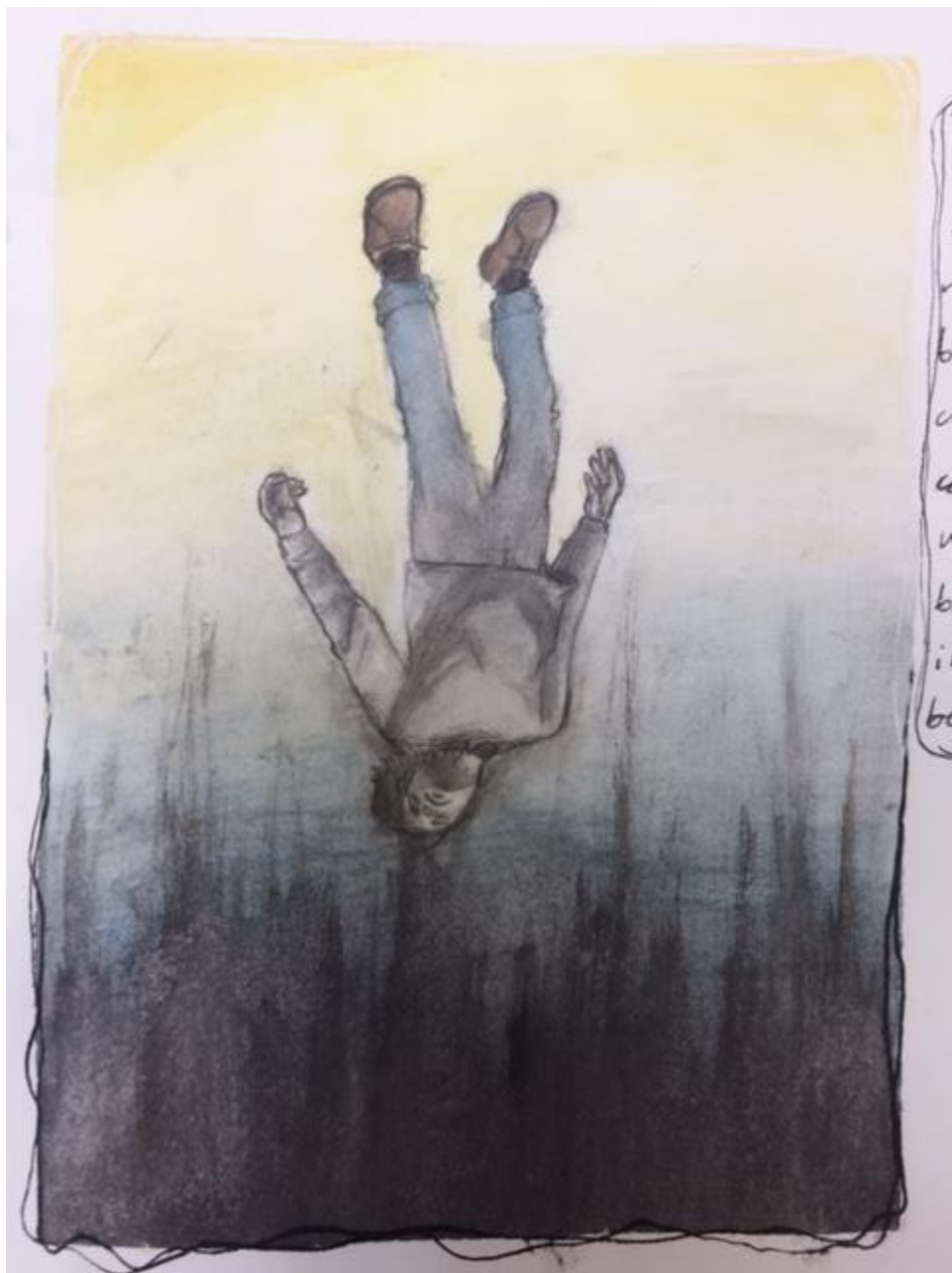
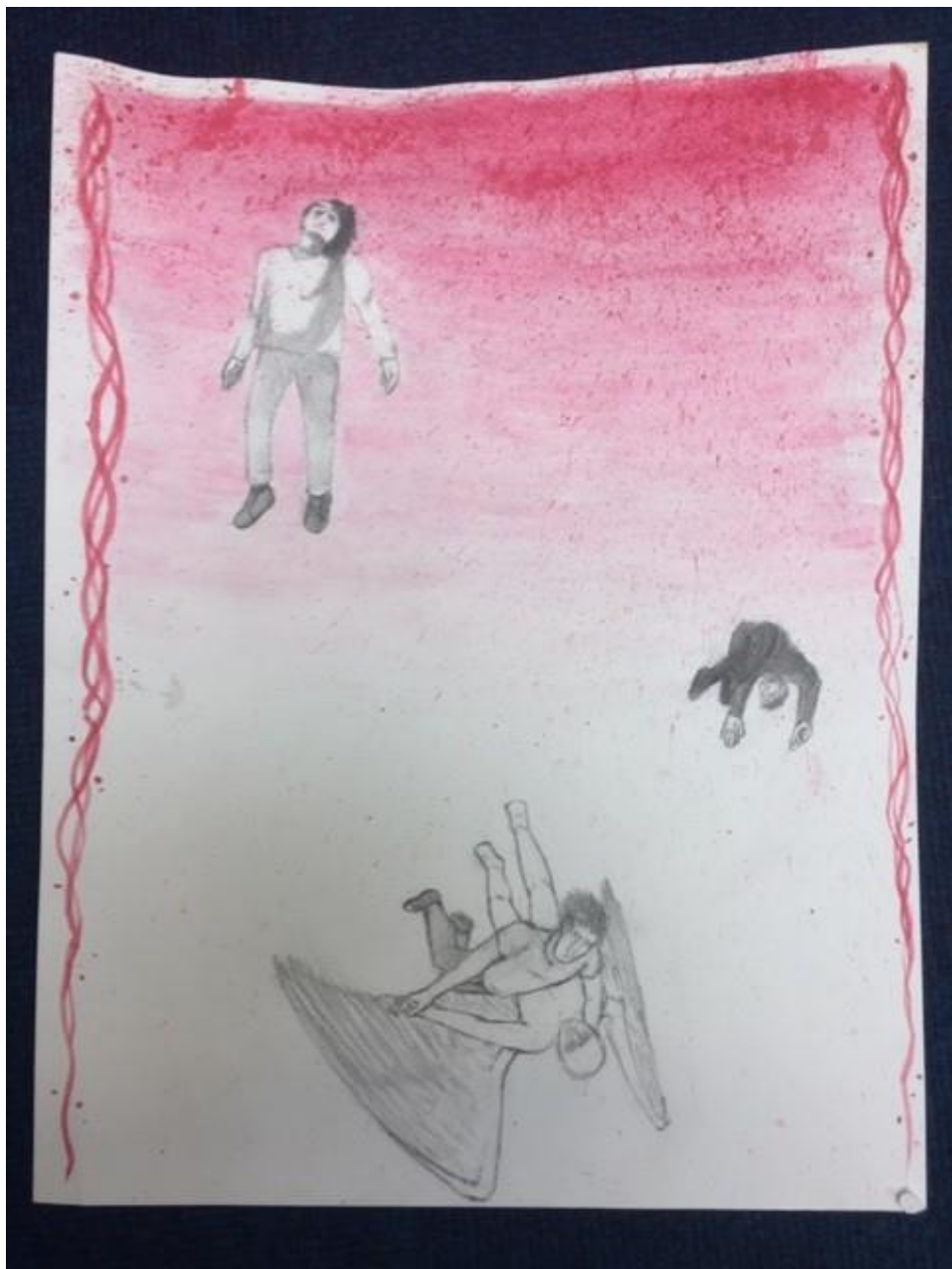
