

Charity and Fundraising



In the Sixth Form, students work closely with a range of charitable organisations to raise awareness of important issues and to fundraise for good causes. Each week, students donate spare change, collect items for local food banks and sell food and drink in aid of charity. Throughout the year, they also organise and support bespoke fundraising events, including our termly fayres and themed charity days such as Christmas Jumper Day.

In recent years, we have supported charities such as CAFOD and Macmillan, as well as raising awareness of challenges faced by women in different parts of the world and highlighting the ongoing crisis in the Congo. This year, Year 12 have chosen to support the British Heart Foundation and Year 13 have selected Newcastle Cats and Dogs Shelter as their designated charities, giving students a clear focus for their efforts.

In addition, some of our students take on the role of CAFOD Young Leaders, receiving training in leadership and social justice and then using these skills to inspire others in the school community to engage with charitable action.
