Our annual Sixth Form Culture Day is a joyful celebration of the many cultures represented within St Mary's. First proposed by the Diversity and Inclusion Committee of the Sixth Form Leadership Team, this event gives students (with the help of some teachers) the opportunity to run stalls that share information about their heritage, sell food and drink linked to their culture, and wear traditional or cultural dress with pride.

Our most recent Culture Day took place on 21 March 2025 and included representatives from over eighteen different cultures, including Turkish, Iraqi, Indian, Pakistani, Polish, Irish, British, Nigerian, Belgian, Serbian, Philippine and Congolese. The stalls were open to Sixth Form students during their Personal Development lesson and to Main School students at lunchtime, creating a vibrant and inclusive whole-school experience.

Over £450 was raised during Culture Day 2025, which was donated to a range of charities chosen by the students, reflecting both their generosity and their commitment to global community.
