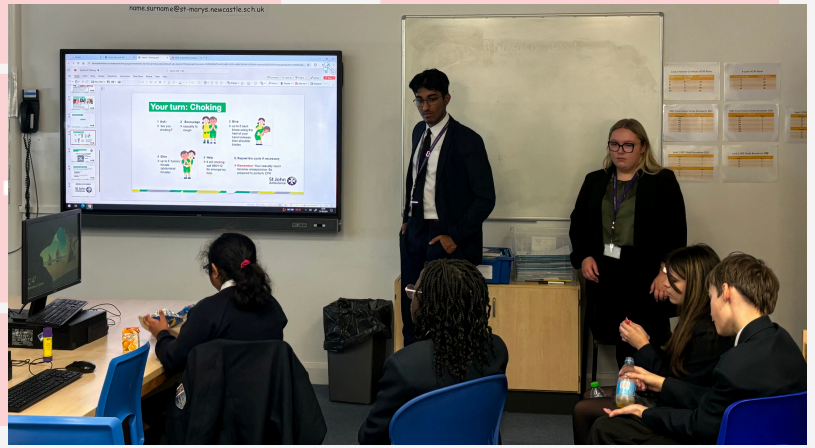


Mentoring and Volunteering
